CITIZEN'S ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Meeting Date: March 1, 2022

CALL TO ORDER:

Chair Cendejas called the meeting to order at 6:33 PM.

DISCUSSION:

David Yanez, City Attorney, started the meeting off by letting the Commission know that the public hearing being held would be the last one required by law. Yanez then went on to give a brief introduction about what David Kaitz, Davis Demographics, would be presenting.

Kaitz presented three possible map scenarios for redrawing the district lines. He reiterated the two maps that were previously presented and introduced a third map which takes into account future development. Kaitz then went over each map individually and explained the differences between them.

Chair Albert Cendejas asked for clarification about what "development" was in reference to.

Daniel James, Assistant City Manager, said it was based on projects that the city is aware of in various stages.

There was then a discussion about what streets were along the district lines.
