- 1. Please go over the parade rules with everyone that is participating.
- 2. <u>City of Dinuba provides a Santa no other</u> <u>Santa's are allowed!</u>
- 3. Parade will take place rain or shine, be prepared for rain.
- 4. Each entry must provide appropriate signage that is large enough to indicate the organization and what it represents.
- Displays must provide their own power.
 The City of Dinuba will not provide electricity or other services.
- 6. No items shall be thrown, sprayed, discarded (including candy).
- 7. Parade assembly entrants can check-in the staging area @ 3:00 pm but no later than 5:00 pm. Subject to change.
- 8. Entrants arriving after 5:00 pm will be placed at the end of the parade (At the discretion of City staff). Judges will not judge late entrants, and the announcer will only acknowledge the business or organization.
- Parade riders are to remain seated, in the center and no edges of flatbeds, while the vehicle moves.
- 10. Flameproof materials and electrical wires must be in good condition.
- 11. Generators and speakers must be secure at all times, have a fire extinguisher on hand with easy access to an adult.
- 12. Vehicles/motorcycles clubs must abide by street safety laws. No revving/burnouts.

- 13. No drugs/alcoholic beverages or smoking of any kind before, during or after the parade. This is a family oriented event.
- 14. Entrants must take with them all items brought to the event at the end of the parade, including hay, paper etc.
- 15. **All equestrian entries** must have a designated person picking up animal droppings before, after and during the parade.
- 16. Entrants must abide by all safety instruction provided by City Staff.
- 17. City of Dinuba reserves the right to exclude/remove entrants whose conduct or entry violate parade criteria or pose safety concerns.
- 18. The City of Dinuba reserves the right to reschedule the date of or cancel the parade in events beyond control.
- 19. In the event of cancellation, or if you do not attend the parade, NO REFUNDS will be provided or credited.
